



Is patient satisfaction related to diagnosis?

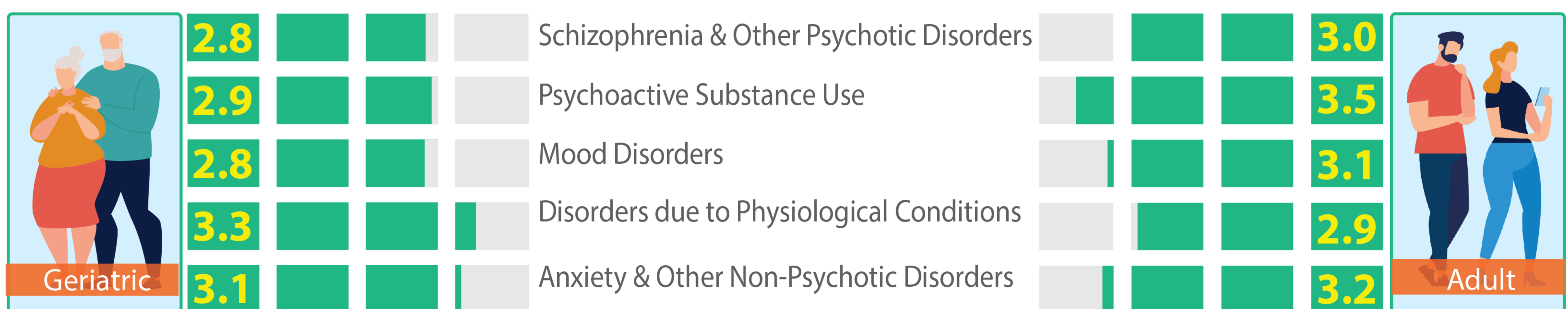
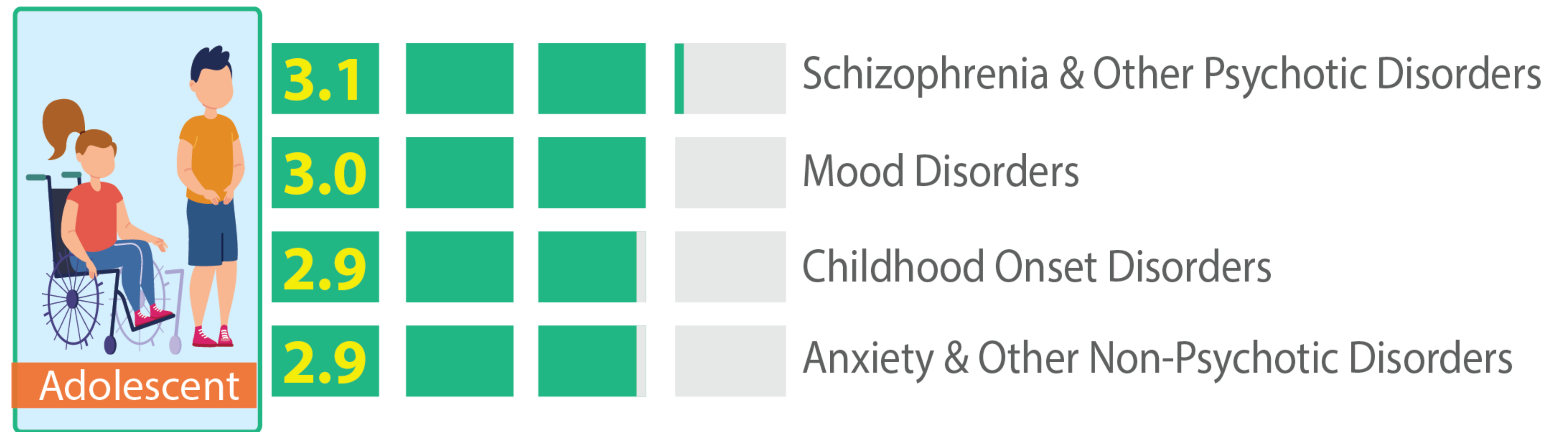
Overall, **3 in 4*** patients are satisfied with their care.



This holds true overall across diagnostic groups.



Even broken down by age, 3 in 4 are satisfied regardless of diagnosis.



As it turns out, diagnosis is not important for patient satisfaction! It's important to remember every patient, no matter their ailment, can feel satisfied with their care.

*Patient Satisfaction is scored on a scale of 0 to 5, where higher scores indicate greater satisfaction. Patients responding 4 or higher are considered satisfied.
